General information

- All prices include the preparation and presentation of the Kiddush.
- If you wish to have balloons (or any other decoration) as table centres, these must be delivered to the Shul the Friday morning before noon.
- Any additions to the menus must be discussed with the Kiddush co-ordinator.
- All Kiddushim must be paid for 4 weeks in advance.
- All prices are for 400 people (an average Shabbat attendance). If you are expecting a large number of guests, please discuss with us.
- Please be aware dairy foods will be Chalav Yisrael.
- Please note that the Shul is a nut-free site and no products containing nuts or peanuts can be brought onto the premises.
- We cannot cater for specific food allergies but aim to provide something that everyone can eat.

Standard Kiddush Food Menu

The standard Simcha Kiddush consists of:

- Dips and crackers
- A choice of *
 - Herring
 - Fishballs
 - Veggie bites
 - Falafel
 - Sweet potato bites
- Olives and pickled cucumbers
- A choice of *
 - Vegetable crudité's
 - Nachos with salsa and avocado dips
- Mixed biscuits
- Crisps
- A choice of *
 - Danish pastries
 - Cake
- A choice of *
 - Sandwiches
 - Bridge rolls
 - Bagels
- Children's biscuits
- Grape juice and squash

* Please select one option, or discuss a combination.

The above Kiddush is £500 for a single Simcha.

If the Kiddush is being shared between multiple Simchas, the cost is £375 (each) for a double and £285 (each) for a triple. This is to take into account the larger number of guests. Any choices will need to take into account the preferences of all the families involved.

Please note this does not include drinks – see overleaf.

Drinks

In addition to the food specified on the previous page, you will need to provide one of the following drink options.

Option 1

- 6 bottles Kiddush wine
- 6 bottles (1 litre) Scotch whisky *

Option 2

- 5 bottles Kiddush wine
- 3 bottles (1 litre) Scotch whisky *
- 4 bottles liqueur (eg 1 or 2 of toffee vodka, Advocaat, cherry brandy, chocolate liqueur etc) **
- 8 bottles (2 litres) fizzy drink (we recommend diet coke and lemonade) ***

Option 3

- 5 bottles Kiddush wine
- 5 bottles (1 litre) Scotch whisky *
- 8 bottles (2 litres) fizzy drink (we recommend diet coke and lemonade) ***
- 16 cartons (1 litre) of apple and/or orange juice

Option 4

- 5 bottles Kiddush wine
- 2 bottles (1 litre) Scotch whisky *
- 2 bottles (1 litre) Pimms (original only)
- 4 bottles (2 litres) lemonade

Shared Kiddush Option (split between the families)

- 6 bottles Kiddush wine
- 6 bottles (1 litre) Scotch whisky *
- 4 bottles liqueur (eg 1 or 2 of toffee vodka, Advocaat, cherry brandy, chocolate liqueur etc) **
- 8 bottles (2 litres) fizzy drink (we recommend diet coke and lemonade) ***

If there are other drinks you wish to provide please discuss with us. We can tailor-make a drinks package for you.

* Please note there may be Kashrut issues with non-Scotch whisky. If you want to use other whisky, please contact the Kiddush co-ordinator.

** These must be purchased from a Kosher supplier as many liqueurs are not Kosher. This often includes things such as store own brand versions of name brand liqueurs which are Kosher. We reserve the right not to serve the drink if we are not certain of its Kashrut.

*** In general most fizzy drinks are Kosher but there are some issues (eg those containing grape juice are not Kosher if not supervised). If you want to buy something different, please contact the Kiddush co-ordinator.

Extras and Bespoke Kiddushim

Extras

- Sweets * £50

- Fruit / Melon £50
- Mini Cupcakes £100

* Please note these are only for the Kiddush – throwing sweets is not allowed in Shul.

If a Simcha is shared both families need to agree the extras and share the cost.
