£25	Taxi for elderly, disabled person to visit spouse in hospital - twice a week
£75	School uniform for one child
£100	Winter coat and shoes for a child
£120	Assistance with additional cost of Pesach for an individual
£180	Hot lunch at school for a child for one term
£350	School coach fares for one term to ensure a child remains at a Jewish school
£500	Emergency funds to a family for a month for food and other essentials
£600	Hot lunch at school for one child for a whole school year
£1,000 +	Assistance for a family with a loss of income (redundancy/illness)
